Application Guidelines

GUIDELINES:

- 1. Student must be a graduating high school senior $\underline{residing}$ and $\underline{attending\ school}$ in $\underline{Hancock}$ County.
- 2. One (1) scholarship application form should be completed per applicant.
- 3. Findlay Service League's Scholarship Committee will consider the following:
 - Community Service
 - Application and Essay
 - > Recommendation Letter
 - ➤ Academic Achievement Minimum GPA of 3.0 is required on a 4.0 Scale
- 4. Financial need is not a consideration. The scholarship is for one year and is non-renewable.
- 5. The application submission must include:
 - a. Fully completed application
 - b. List of your volunteer activities
 - c. Letter of recommendation
 - d. Copy of your transcript
 - e. Essav
- 6. The essay must be one-page, typed, double-spaced and describe the applicant's most impactful service/volunteer experience.
- 7. For confidentiality reasons, please <u>do not</u> include your name on the essay portion (only) of the application process.
- 8. The selection and announcement of the recipient will take place in April 2024.
- 9. The scholarship check will be mailed directly to the college or university that the applicant will attend in the Fall of 2024.
- 10. Finalists may be interviewed by Findlay Service League's Scholarship Committee.
