### Application Guidelines

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#### **GUIDELINES:**

1. Student must be a graduating high school senior residing and attending school in Hancock County.
  2. One (1) scholarship application form should be completed per applicant.
  3. Findlay Service League's Scholarship Committee will consider the following:
    - Community Service
    - Application and Essay
    - Recommendation Letter
    - Academic Achievement – Minimum GPA of 3.0 is required on a 4.0 Scale
  4. Financial need is not a consideration. The scholarship is for one year and is non- renewable.
  5. The application submission must include:
    - a. Fully completed application
    - b. List of your volunteer activities
    - c. Letter of recommendation
    - d. Copy of your transcript
    - e. Essay
  6. The essay must be one-page, typed, double-spaced and describe the applicant's most impactful service/volunteer experience.
  7. For confidentiality reasons, please do not include your name on the essay portion (only) of the application process.
  8. The selection and announcement of the recipient will take place in April 2024.
  9. The scholarship check will be mailed directly to the college or university that the applicant will attend in the Fall of 2024.
  10. Finalists may be interviewed by Findlay Service League's Scholarship Committee.
